## Studying at Radboud University


At Radboud University we educate students to become committed, critical and self-confident graduates who help shape society.



#### **Application procedure**

Apply online for the Bachelor's or Master's programme of your choice in two steps:

- · Submit your application in Studielink
- Upload your documents to Radboud application portal - Osiris Application
   It takes approx. 3 weeks for you to receive your official admission decision.

#### **Accommodation**

#### **Pre-Master's students**

Radboud University has made arrangements with Nijmegen's Student Housing Association (SSH&) that Pre Master's students can register for the lottery for a room, provided you have a letter of acceptance from Radboud University. If you win a room via this lottery you can stay in it for the duration of your Pre-Master's programme. Most student rooms are close to the University and can easily be reached by bus or bicycle, but are not furnished. Want to try and find a room by yourself, please check: www.ru.nl/student-accommodation

#### **Master's students**

We help you find accommodation.

Radboud University tries to mediate in student housing for international students who come to Nijmegen for a Master's programme, provided you apply before 1 April (non-EU/EEA) and 1 May (EU/EEA). Most student rooms are close to the University and can easily be reached by bus or bicycle. Room contracts are for the normal duration of your regular (1 or 2 year) programme and rooms are furnished. A furnished room with shared facilities costs between €370 and €650 per calendar month. www.ru.nl/housing

#### **Bachelor's students**

Radboud University has made arrangements with Nijmegen's Student Housing Association (SSH&) that BA students can register for the lottery for a room from 1 June, provided you have a letter of acceptance from Radboud University. If you win a room via this lottery you can stay in it for the duration of your BA programme. Most student rooms are close to the University and can easily be reached by bus or bicycle, but are not furnished. 
